TRINITY COMMONS FOUNDATION

The Trinity Commons Foundation's mission is to see that what the voters approved in 1998 becomes reality.

In 2009, we have:

- Through our South Dallas Education Initiative, made presentations at 165 community meetings reaching 5006 citizens. We have also had booths and tables at large community events attended by 79,796 citizens.
- Sponsored the fifth annual Trinity River Levee Top Run with over 800 participants making it our biggest ever. This event features the Glenn Carter Public Safety Challenge which is a special run that is a competition between the Dallas Police Department and the Dallas Fire Rescue.
- Partnered with the City of Dallas and the Trinity Trust to host luncheons and tours of the Trinity for Transportation Secretary Lahood and Assistant Secretary of the Army JoEllen Darcy.
- Partnered with the Fort Worth Water District, the Office of the Governor of Louisiana and the Yazoo-Mississippi Delta Levee District to address issues relating to flood control on a regional level.
- Begun hosting quarterly Trinity briefings to representatives of 29 business organizations by City Manager Suhm.
- Attended the monthly Trinity Interagency Team Meetings composed of 22 representatives of various City Departments and government agencies that are involved with the Project.
- Coordinated a response to the suggestion that the Texas Historical Commission consider listing the Trinity Levees and the Design District on the National Register.
- Held our 8th annual Trinity luncheon attended by 800 people. Major General Merdith W. B. Temple, Deputy Commanding General for Civil and Emergency Operations for the U. S. Army corps of Engineers spoke as did Mayor Leppert.
